

# WHAT TO KNOW ABOUT IUOE LOCAL 150 DUES

IUOE Local 150 will take 3% of your gross pay every month in the form of dues. The union also charges an initiation fee that ranges from **\$30.00 to \$512.50 per new member.\***



## TAKE A LOOK:

| IF YOU EARN                          | \$22.15/HR | \$31/HR    | \$40.79/HR |
|--------------------------------------|------------|------------|------------|
| Monthly Dues                         | \$115.18   | \$161.20   | \$212.11   |
| Annual Dues                          | \$1,382.16 | \$1,934.40 | \$2,545.29 |
| Dues paid over a three-year contract | \$4,146.47 | \$5,803.19 | \$7,635.87 |

## Who else expects more than \$115 every month from you?

Remember, dues deducted from your paycheck after taxes means less take-home pay. And union dues/fees are not tax deductible.

Illinois is not a right-to-work state. IUOE Local 150 can legally negotiate union security language that could require you to pay dues, fees, and assessments to the union just to keep your job.
