UNION NEGOTIATIONS AREN'T NORMALLY A QUICK FIX

If IUOE Local 150 wins an election at WillScot, both parties have a legal obligation to bargain in good faith for a contract covering all terms and conditions of employment.

It sounds simple, but it can be a long and complicated process. On average, it takes 465 days to negotiate a first contract.



WHY DOES IT TAKE SO LONG?

The law requires the union and the employer to meet and exchange proposals about wages, benefits and all other conditions of employment like scheduling, overtime, transfer and promotion rules, holiday and vacation time off and other matters.

The parties are not required to reach an agreement.* And there is no guarantee the union will negotiate for issues that are important to you personally.
