



# You already receive generous market-competitive pay and benefits.

Your WillScot pay and benefits are competitive with similar positions in our area, and you don't have to give up more than \$115 a month to a union. Don't get locked into whatever the union negotiates for you.

# To avoid the uncertainty of collective bargaining.

No one knows what could happen in bargaining. You could end up with less, more or the same as you have

# To be free from potentially having to pay dues to IUOE Local 150.
